

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on January 5, 1981 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of December 15, 1981 meeting be approved as presented.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following ordinance be passed on second reading: "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia providing for control of Erosion and Sedimentation: Adopting minimum plans and control techniques as set forth in Current Virginia Erosion and Sedimentation Control Handbook: non-controlled Exemptions: Establishing Procedures, administration and Enforcement: Providing penalties for Violations and Repealing Conflicting Ordinance." On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution "Of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, stipulating the City's Agreement to Provisions as set forth by the Virginia Department of Highways and Transportation and the Commission of Outdoor Recreation" be passed. On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following ordinance "Providing for the Removal or Immobilization of Motor Vehicles against which there are outstanding Parking Violations, Illegal Parking or Parking over Two Hours Overtime in a Limited Time Zone" be passed on first reading and that public hearing on this ordinance be held on January 19th at 7:30 P.M.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that go into executive session for consideration of personnel and pending litigation.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.

W.F. McElroy nominated Ron C. McCall to fill the unexpired term of James F. Gates on City of Norton School Board, said term to expire June 30, 1982.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Ron C. McCall by acclamation member of City of Norton School Board for term to expire June 30, 1982.

The City Manager advised council the city was in need of two dump trucks and that he had found two trucks in good condition for the sum of \$6,350.00 and had purchased same and would like this purchase ratified.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that purchase of two dump trucks in amount of \$6350.00 be ratified.

Vice Mayor McElroy introduced a motion to award the City Manager, G.M. Newman, a bonus in the amount of \$5,374.20, which represents 20% of his base salary, payable in 1982 out of 1980-81 surplus, this award given for his outstanding performance as city manager. The motion was seconded by Robert Collier, with request of Cliff Daniels to second the second. On roll call vote, this motion was unanimous.

Councilman Jones spoke briefly to council regarding downtown revitalization program. He stated he would like to see the council endorse a program and put in laps of the Planning Commission for this downtown revitalization. Council discussed this matter briefly and advised Mr. Jones that two members of Planning Commission were present and would be able to present to other members of the Commission plans for this downtown parking.


The City Manager advised council as of January 5th the City had 110 million gallons water.
