

A public hearing on removal or immobilization of motor vehicles was held in the Municipal Court Room on January 20, 1982 at 7:30 P.M.

An "Ordinance Providing for the Removal or Immobilization of Motor Vehicles Against which there are Outstanding Parking Violations, Illegal Parking or Parking over two hours Overtime in a Limited Time Zone" was presented.

Attorney Asbury explained the ordinance with regard to purpose and need for such an ordinance. Mayor Hunnicutt called upon citizens present to ask any questions or to discuss this ordinance with council. Steve Marshall of 527 Ridge Avenue spoke several times - asking questions with regard to this ordinance. Council discussed this ordinance at length after which they ask the City Attorney to prepare another ordinance after checking with City of Bristol for a copy of their ordinance.

Mayor Hunnicutt announced that council would now go into regular session.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of January 5th meeting be approved as presented.

Richard Phelps, representing Norton Little League, was present requesting funds for the Little League. Council discussed this matter with Mr. Phelps and ask that he get in touch with City Manager before he gets budget made. They advised he was now beginning to formulate his budget. Mr. Phelps advised they were in need of some help around the Little League Field. He advised that in-field was all full of rock; high wall has holes in it and in danger of falling; problem with water running off at bleachers causing dirt to go down on bleachers. He also ask if it would be possible to have a dumpster out there due to so much garbage. These matters were referred to Mr. Newman for having checked out.

Consideration of purchase of 4-wheel ^Rdrive vehicle.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that City Manager be authorized to purchase for sum not over \$7,485.00 4-wheel drive pick-up and plow, funds to come out of capital outlay.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel and consideration pending contract.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.

The item pending contract has to do with situation that has been in process of developing for some time regarding infiltration of sewage system. It now appears in line with their general method of operation the State Water Control Board is going to get hard boiled about the massive infiltration as reported to this council two or three different occasions, consequently it is going to be necessary to get additional personnel to first plan and then expedite the elimination of that infiltration. The City Manager has been authorized and directed to proceed to arrive at a solution to that plan of preventing excessive infiltration in the sewer plant.

Councilman Vic Jones nominated Bruce Fraley as member of Norton Redevelopment & Housing Authority for four year term, said term to begin January 28, 1982 thru January 28, 1986.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Bruce Fraley reappointed to Norton Redevelopment and Housing Authority for period of 4 years, said term expiring Jan. 28, 1986.

Robert Bolling, T/A The Sportsman appeared before council regarding issuance of pool room license for 1982.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that Robert Bolling, T/A The Sportsman be granted permission for issuance of pool room license for 1982.
