

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on March 2, 1982 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of February 17, 1982 be adopted as presented.

Betty Duncan representing the Wise Clean County Committee appeared before council presenting a proclamation for council's consideration.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution regarding dates for clean-up to coincide with State and County Cleanup was passed. (Insert)

Consideration, State Water Control Board Mandate, Update and recommended procedures. Ron Peak, City Engineer presented infiltration/inflow report to council with recommended procedures in line with State Water Control Board. Council discussed this matter at length with Mr. Peake.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, the following resolution "Approving the Infiltration and Inflow Study of the City of Norton Sewage System and Adopting a plan and Schedule of Commitment" was passed. (Insert)

"Red" Owens, representing VFW was present regarding use of room in Municipal Building for meetings once a month. Council briefly discussed this with Mr. Owens and advised him to schedule this from meeting to meeting.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution "Of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, inviting the Board of Supervisors of Wise County and the Town Councils of the other towns in Wise County, Virginia to participate in a cooperate meeting to distribute coal Haul Road Severance Tax Money in Wise County and the City of Norton Virginia" be passed. On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to consider appointment and pending contract.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session. Mayor Hunnicutt reported they had at least one pending contract dissolved-Agreement with U.S. Forest Service to exchange a tract of land with the Forest Service is for a piece of land on Guest River. This piece of land which belongs to City of Norton is in the Lost Creek Watershed and not in the Benges Branch. It is not considered any value to City of Norton except as potential right of way for water line. The Forest Service has broken tradition and has agreed to reserve the right to the city to maintain a 20' easement for water lines that could be placed there. We are authorizing a final agreement to be made subject to scrutiny of council at another time.

The other pending contract concerning contract for engineering services on Clear Creek Water Shed, which has been stalemated for six or eight weeks and we hope to bring to a head within next seven days at which time there will be further announcement on that.

On consideration of appointment, council decided to await full council before making the appointment.

Acting City Manager Brown advised council use of old Indian Creek Tire & Recapping Pad for a basketball court was proposed. He advised there would be little cost but were only interested in knowing if City would assume the whole responsibility and relieve highway department of any responsibility. Council was in agreement with this plan. The City Attorney is to draw up a resolution covering same.

Mr. Brown presented report of Richard Prior regarding Market Place Project.

Mr. Brown briefly discussed with council ad for city manager.
