

A continued meeting of the City Council of the March 2, 1982 meeting was held in the Municipal Court Room on March 9, 1982 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Robert Collier, Cliff Daniels, Vic Jones

Also Present: Earle Brown, Acting City Manager

Council discussed a proposed supplemental ordinance prohibiting the Drainage of storm water or surface water in the City of Norton Sewer System and Prescribing Penalties for violations thereof.. Mayor Hunnicutt read the ordinance in its entirety.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, "Prohibiting the Drainage of Storm Water or Surface Water into the City of Norton Sewer System and prescribing penalties for violations thereof" be passed. On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss pending contracts.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt stated council had hammered out an agreement with James A. Brown authorizing the Acting City Manager to commit the City of Norton to provide water services to B.J. Allison Company for proposed shopping center on West side of U.S. #23 between Norton and Wise. Mayor Hunnicutt read the agreement in its entirety.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the Acting City Manager be authorized and directed to notify the B.J. Allison Company that water will be furnished to shopping center under terms as set out in the paper just read.

Mayor Hunnicutt stated the second thing hammered out in executive session was contract with Wiley & Wilson, Engineers.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the Acting City Manager be authorized and directed to execute contract an addendum to the contract with Wiley & Wilson, Inc. of Lynchburg, Virginia, to cover engineering services to be provided for implementing the Clear Creek Water Project. Also execute a contract for the addendum providing for certain services to be provided by City forces, said sum for services not to exceed \$145,000.00, said sum to be reimbursed by F.H.A. loan which in turn was authorized by a bond issue passed on by voters of City of Norton. Mr. Metropulos, Finance Director, presented three items for council's consideration at next council meeting.

1. The restricted reserve funds have been prepared for next year. Those accounts should be in your notebooks, and available for your review.
2. Council must decide on one of the four options presented by the former city manager, so that we can proceed on the Water Operating Fund Budget.
3. We need to transfer money to 4101-1001 (2001 Acct) so we can pay the engineering.
