

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 6, 1982 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Minutes of March 16, 1982 meeting were presented and discussed,

On motion made and duly seconded council moved that paragraph 10397 be amended to read as follows: 1. No capital cost to the City. 2. Subject to approval State Water Control Board, and this in the sole judgment of the City of Norton. 3. Subject to prior execution of proper easements. 4. Same rules and regulations as if the property were located within the City limits. This applies the same as paragraph 10401 in March 9, 1982 minutes.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that approval of minutes of March 16, 1982 meeting be postponed until amended and brought before the council at next meeting.

Mrs. Ruth Mundy of Chapman Street appeared before council regarding law against cats in the corporation of Norton.

Mayor Hunnicutt advised that due to absence of City Attorney they would not be able to give any kind of answer to her question.

Mr. Joseph Irajbansee of Copper Kettle Restaurant appeared before council asking for sewer connection. He stated this matter had been taken up with State Water Control Board, State Health Department and County Health Department. Council discussed this at length due to moratorium on sewer and water connections outside the City. Council ask if he was aware of having to have a grease trap, water line size, etc. Council instructed the applicant to get a signed letter from State Water Control Board stating it would be alright to have this connection made.

Buzzy Witt, representing Norton Insurance Agency was present and presented break-down on city's Special Multi-Peril Comprehensive Policy. Council discussed this matter at length with Mr. Witt. Council ask that Mr. Witt & Mr. Metropolis work out report on the insurance, giving amount have insured on building and contents and list of assets.

Mr. Hoyt Williams of T. & L. and Mr. Prior, Planner for the City appeared before council in regard to change orders for the Market Place Project. Mr. Prior presented status report on cost of project to date. Gary Tucker of T. & L. explained the overrun of the original project cost. Council discussed this matter with engineers at length. The engineers presented need for an increase in engineering fees for this project. Council ask that the engineers come back at next council meeting with a negotiating price

F.H.A. - Engineering Resolution and changes - On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved the adoption of resolution regarding development of Clear Creek Raw Water Source as read. (Insert)

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution approved the appointment of Mike Quillen to Lenowisco Board of Directors be passed. (Insert)

Mr. Metropolis spoke to council briefly on budget and ask when their pleasure was for work session. Council advised work session would be after school budget was presented.

Option - Virginia Supplemental Retirement System. On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that accept option A 5.62 as already agreed in budget.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared council back in regular session.

Robert Collier nominated John Litton as member of City of Norton Planning Commission to fill unexpired term of Wright Dawson, said term to expire July 31, 1983.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

John Litton was declared a member of City of Norton Planning Commission to fill unexpired term of Wright Dawson, said term to expire July 31, 1983.

Mayor Hunnicutt advised Council they had been advised by the Commonwealth of Energy Audit which could be made if city so desires.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that City Manager be authorized and directed to request the Department of Emergency and Energy Services to make an audit of the facilities of City of Norton with respect to energy useage.

Councilman Jones stated he would like the City Engineer to give a report twice a month to the council regarding infiltration problem the city has. Council and the engineer were in agreement for this to be done.

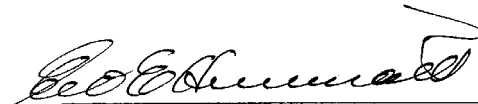
