

The City Council met on May 19, 1981 with City of Norton School Board for consideration of School Board Budget.

Dr. Jim Graham presented proposed school budget to City Council, Dr. Culbertson ask that Mr. Newman explain or summarize budget of the City. City Council and School Board discussed the proposed budget in detail. After this lengthy discussion, Council advised the School Board they would have to meet again before finalizing the budget but now they were aware of what they were looking for.

The regular meeting of the City Council was held on May 19, 1981 after meeting with City of Norton School Board, with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion made & duly seconded P.W. Metropulos was appointed Secretary pro-tem for this meeting of May 19th.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of May 5th meeting be approved as presented.

Octavia Stidham appeared before council inquiring of status of her request for street light on May 5th.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that a street light be installed at 13th Street, S.E. & Flanary Avenue.

Mr. Newman presented a study made by Old Dominion Power Company of street lights in City. Council discussed this matter briefly.

Councilman Daniels ask that Attorney Asbury prepare a resolution stating the lighting is insufficient. Council agreed for this resolution to be passed.

Attorney Asbury presented ordinance to City Council regarding vacating certain alley lying in Green subdivision.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by the following votes: Hunnicutt, McElroy, Collier, Daniels, YES; Jones abstained, Council moved that the following ordinance be adopted. (Insert)

Mr. Newman presented resolution "Withdrawing any opposition to the Rechanneling of Guest River on East Park Avenue in the City of Norton, Virginia, and requesting the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to issue their permit to Tabb, Inc." Resolution tabled until next council meeting.

Mr. Newman advised council that the City needed to transfer \$37,090 to N.I.D.A. and needs council's approval for the transfer. Council discussed this matter briefly.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that matter of transfer be tabled until documents are seen to support this transfer.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that go into executive session to discuss personnel matters.

On motion by Robert Collier, Seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt advised the executive session covered appointment of two members to N.I.D.A. for 4 year term, expiring May 10, 1985.

Robert Collier moved that W.C. Witt & Wright Dawson be appointed as members of N.I.D.A. for four year term, said term to expire May 10, 1985.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed

Mayor Hunnicutt declared W.C. Witt and Wright Dawson members of N.I.D.A. for four year term, said term to expire May 10, 1985.

Mr. Newman advised Council he had received 16 applications for Recreation Director. He ask if council would like to nominate a review committee for these. Council stated it was the City Manager's "Ball Game".

Councilman Collier brought council up-to-date on Norton Clean & Beautiful Commission project on Tipple-Hill beautification. He stated they were in need of \$4800.00. He presented a list of materials. Mr. Collier stated he could get civic groups and private contributions. He ask the City for \$1200.00 contribution. He states he thinks the City should have a vested interest. Council briefly discussed this matter.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that give \$1200.00 to Norton Clean & Beautiful Commission, provided \$3600.00 is raised separately.

Mr. Newman advised council he would like to have a budget workshop Thursday. Council agreed for workshop to be Thursday at 3:00 P.M.
