

June 2, 1981

Council met in executive session for a joint meeting with City of Norton School Board to discuss personnel.

On motion made and duly seconded council moved they go back into regular session.

Mayor Hunnicutt advised that two appointments to School Board will be made this month. Dr. Culbertson and Mrs. Clements have agreed to reappointment.

Christina Edwards ask if there was two positions on School Board open. Mayor Hunnicutt advised there was no openings to council's knowledge. He also advised that Dr. Culbertson and Mrs. Clements had agreed to serve for another year until replacements can be found.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized to advertise for bids for street paving as per budgeted amount.

Stan Wilson appeared before council as coach & athletic director of High School requesting financial aid for recreation program for summer for older people. He requested the sum of \$2,000.00. After a brief discussion council ask that Stan bring necessary figures to Mr. Newman for consideration.

Consideration, Transfer of Funds (N.I.D.A.) Mr. Newman presented a resolution for consideration. Councilman Daniels stated that after further investigation he would like to move that this be tabled again. Council agreed for this to be tabled.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution with reference to street lighting system be as passed as read. (Insert)

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution "Amending the 1980 Community Development Block Grant, approving the 1981 Community Development Block Grant Application, and amending the 1979 Entitlement Grant be passed as read.(insert).

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session for discussion of personnel.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that Edward F. Tate be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment to City of Norton Board of Zoning Appeals for a period of five (5) years.

Robert Collier nominated Jenny Stokes for appointment to Wise County Regional Library Board for a period of four years.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved nominations be closed.

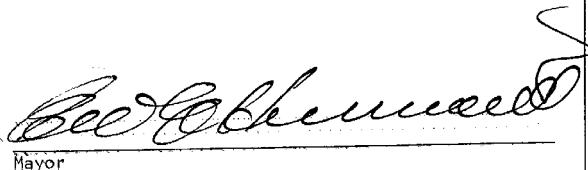

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Jenny Stokes as member of Wise County Regional Library Board for term of four years.

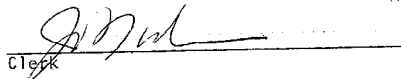
