

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 7, 1981, at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W. F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of June 16th and continued meeting of June 23rd be approved as presented.

Martha Gardner of Guest River section of the City was present at Council, representing about 15 families up on the hill at end of City limits. She was requesting road, city street lights and larger water line. She stated there was 29 cars using this road daily and that road was in very bad condition. She also stated she and Mrs. John Bledsoe also had been paying for light for ten years but had recently discontinued it. John Bledsoe also spoke on matter stressing the need for a larger water line. Also no garbage pick-up. Council discussed this matter briefly and city manager advised this street was on end of paving list and would be taken care of this year. He advised he was not aware they hadn't been picking up garbage but he would investigate it. Also street light survey was in process. Council referred matter to City Manager.

Anthony Stone representing Norton Rescue Squad presented proposal to council regarding additional unit on their present building. His request to city was for \$4,000.00 from city. Council discussed this matter with Mr. Stone. Council ask that Rescue Squad get all information they need and amount of money received from door to door canvas and get with Mr. Newman to have an amount ready for presentation at next council meeting.

Leaton Harding, speaking in behalf of Norton Jaycees presented proposal for Fall Festival. Council discussed this matter briefly and advised they didn't see any problem with having festival but the City did not have anything to do with school property as far as use of it. Ken McNew advised he had already discussed this with school but would have to go before the school board and that nothing was scheduled at this time but a football game.

Mr. Don Pippin presented proposal for repair of Elementary School Roof. He explained in detail the different kinds of roof proposals he had received. Council discussed this matter at length with Mr. Pippin.

On motion by W. F. McElroy, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous rool call vote, Council moved that instruct School Board to go ahead and get roof fixed, \$25,000.00 to come out of surplus of 1980-81 budget, if not from Revenue Sharing, if not borrow the money.

Consideration - Request for additional funds - Planning and Design Associates. Mr. Prior gave council a brief rundown on additional things which had to be done to new development that was not in original contract. Council discussed this matter briefly and moved to table matter until more information on what we have received for what we paid for.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that go into executive session to discuss pending contract and personnel.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W. F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, council moved they go back into regular session.

W. F. McElroy nominated Walter H. Witt, III for recommendation to Judge of circuit court for appointment as member of Board of Zoning Appeals to serve the unexpired term of Alfred Bowles, said term to expire June 2, 1983.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W. F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Walter H. Witt III as nominee for recommendation to Judge of Circuit Court for appointment as member of Board of Zoning Appeals, said term to expire June 2, 1983.

On motion by Robert Collier, seconded by W. F. McElroy and carried by the following roll call votes, Council moved that Engineering firm of Wiley & Wilson, Lynchburg, Va. be hired as Engineers of Clear Creek Water Project, subject to approval of F.H.A.; Hunnicutt, Yes, Collier, Yes, McElroy, Yes, Daniels, abstained.

The City Manager advised council paving program began yesterday and should continue 2-2½ weeks.

He advised he had engaged Highway Markings, Inc. of Orange, Va. to do street marking this year.

10215

Mr. Newman advised he had received word from State Water Control there would be no funds available for sewer system evaluation.

Newman advised council there was 250-300 present at 4th July celebration. He also commented that he thought Mrs. Moorman was doing a fine job.

Vice Mayor McElroy as if they were going to get anything done to basketball court.

Councilman Daniels advised the tennis courts needed two new lights. City Manager reported dams were full but not running over.
