

Continued session of meeting of March 4th was held in the Municipal Court Room on March 14th at 4:00 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Also Present: G.M. Newman, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

Larry Couch, Town Manager of Wise, Greg Edens, Treasurer and four councilmen from Town of Wise were present at this meeting.

Mr. Newman presented resolution of the Wise County Board of Supervisors regarding Planning District #1 Mental Health and Mental Retardation Program.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that the City Attorney be directed to prepare resolution to withhold 4th quarter local matching funds with exception of amount of \$316.65 local matching funds for Mental Retardation Funds. 9752

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote the following resolution "Directing the Filing of a Step II Application for the Wise-Norton Regional Sewerage Project under the Federal 201 Program" was passed. (Insert) 9753

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that City Manager be authorized to instruct T. & L. to start on Step II application at maximum fee of \$4,000.00, which money is to be split 57% City of Norton, 43% Town of Wise, funds to come from miscellaneous. 9754

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Robert Collier and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the following resolution "Inviting the Establishment of the Regional Office of Surface Mining in the City" be passed. (Insert) 9755

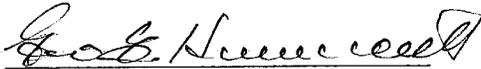
On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized to spend the sum of \$27,635.99 for backhoe Case 580C at figure of approximately \$1,000 more than lower bid for stated reason this machine has features more applicable to our use and more available service in this area, money to be taken out of contingency fund. 9756

Council discussed briefly Memorandum regarding Revenue Sharing with relation to discrimination case of City of Norton. 9757

Mayor Hunnicutt advised council he was resigning from Health Service Board and he thought it advisable to have a member of the council on this Board. Council was to give this consideration at later date. 9758

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Frank Fischer and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that pass resolution requesting Department of Highways & Transportation give first priority to Esserville and Norton Route 23 project from interchange to Esserville and add 58 from interchange to tie in where four-lane ends now. (Insert) 9759
