


A special called meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on October 13, 1980 at 4:00 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Also Present: G.M. Newman, City Manager and Ralph Gilley

This meeting was called for purpose of discussing the water shortage situation. Council discussed the situation at length. Council was in agreement to use days supply instead of gallonage. After first ten days, the ordinance would be put in force. They also discussed not penalizing minimum users of water. They ask that city manager go ahead and contact Wise to see if they would be able to buy water from them. They also instructed the city manager to have meeting with news media to relay situation of water to them and to ask people to cooperate in conserving water supply.
