

A special meeting of the City Council of Norton was held on November 23, 1977 at 10:00 A.M. in the Court Room of the Municipal Building.

Mayor Fulks announced that the purpose of this meeting is to conduct a session on the proposed P.G.R. Enterprises Franchise Agreement to Century Communications Corporation.

Council discussed the matter of transfer at length with Mr. Otto Ohland, Century Communications Corporation.

Mr. Ohland stated that in the future any application for rate increase would be for 1- inflation, 2-improvement in service, 3-purchase price is not a factor in the rate increase.

Mr. McElroy Reported that he was satisfied that they were financially respectable.

On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Vernon Flanary and carried by unanimous roll call vote (Fulks, McElroy, Hunnicutt, Flanary, Yes) council moved that permission be granted P.G.R. Enterprises to transfer T.V. Cable Franchise to Century Communications Corporation.

Councilman Hunnicutt moved, seconded by Vernon Flanary that council discuss million gallon water tank with reference to need and finances for same. Council discussed this matter at length but delayed action until public notification.

There being no further business to come before the council same adjourned.
