The City Manager discussed with Council Vandalism in the City of Norton. 6347 On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the following resolution regarding vandalism be published. (Page 68)

Jim Campbell appeared before council with two girls from Flag Corpsrequesting use of City property behind swimming pool for concession stand.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote council moved that the Flag Corpsof the J.I. Burton High School be permitted to use City Property immediately behind the swimming pool for concession stand, said organization to buy required license and abide by all ordinances of the City of Norton.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote the following resolution approving the Neighborhood Development Program Annual Increment, filing of application for Financial Assistance, The Redevelopment Plan 6349

as Amended by Amendment No.1, and Feasibility of Relocation for Program No. Va. A-8. wassadopted. (Page 68)

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous vote the following resolution approving a Cooperation Agreement with the Norton 6350 Redevelopment and Housing Authority was passed. (Page 68).
