

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 6, 1972, at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved.

Mr. Maurice Wooten of Murphy Street appeared before Council requesting a street light be installed near his residence.

Councilman Fultz brought to council's attention need for street light near Johnny Boggs residence at foot of Hamner Avenue. 6032

On motion by Archie Woods, seconded by Ike Fultz and carried by unanimous vote Council moved that street light be installed on Murphy Street near Wooten's residence and at foot of Hamner Hill near Johnny Boggs residence.

Mr. Wooten complimented the City Manager on hiring college youth for summer employment. 6033

A group of citizens appeared before council inquiring as to appointments of school board members and also who does firing of same. Citizens speaking were Mrs. Carl Lawson, Mrs. Emily Shoop, Charlie Thompson, Mrs. Thompson, Dr. Ingram, Mrs. Dean, Mrs. Booher, Joe Kilgore. Council advised they did the appointments to school board but had never had an occasion or situation to remove anyone from school board. 6034

Dr. Ingram asked if there was any provision made whereby a person could be removed from school board.

Councilman Fultz suggested that City Manager take this matter up with City Attorney as to legality and also with the State.

Mr. Lunsford spoke to Council regarding all publicity this school matter had gotten which he felt was not good for City School or City. He was of the opinion this matter should have been looked into and prevented from going to Sawmill Hollow. *Carl*

Mrs. McArthur requested street light on 14th Street. 6035

Charlie Thacker suggested a bell be installed at the railroad crossing going into Sawmill Hollow. 6036

Jean Baker complained of motorcycles, scooter running up and down street in front of her property causing her dog to snap at children. 6037

Mr. Franks advised Council that he had met with Fred Benton and John Hincer of the C & P Telephone Company and Mr. Frank Boxley of Southwest Construction Company to discuss the possibility of rerouting the C & P Conduit from the Southside of Park Avenue to the Northside of Park Avenue in the 500 Block. Mr. Benton, Mr. Hincer, and Mr. Boxley stated that they would have been happy to consider this request for relocating the cable into the sidewalk area North of Park Avenue if they had known it prior to awarding a contract for this work. They stated that due to this change it would

require re-letting a contract for this work due to the additional amount of materials and labor that would be involved in the increased pavement crossings going back to required locations on the Southside of Park Avenue. He explained to them that the City was willing to pay the additional cost in the restoration of the sidewalk and utility services that would be involved if the conduit was located on the Northside of Park Avenue. The contractor then re-emphasized that he did prefer to stay on the Southside of Park Avenue due to the complications that would be involved if he were required to try to relocate his work.

Councilman Fultz as member of Highway Safety Committee recommended that for the safety of children at Swimming Pool that two parking meters above gate to pool be removed during pool season with no Parking Signs placed in section. Council was in agreement for these meters to be removed.

Mr. Franks discussed with Council joint sewer lines with City of Norton and Town of Wise. Council instructed the City Manager to set up meeting with Town of Wise to go into this matter further. Said meeting to be at 2:30 p.m., Thursday.
