On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by V.O. Flanary and carried by unanimous roll call vote the following resolution was passed: 2394


THAT, WHEREAS, the City of Norton, Virginia, did at a special meeting determine that it would be expedient and to the best interest of the City of Norton, Virginia, that said council do support the APPALACHIAN--WISE ASSOCIATION OF REHABILITATION AND EDUCATION, INC., a non-profit organization formed under the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE it resolved, that the city council for the City of Norton, Virginia, in conformity with its action heretofore taken on the 17th day of November, 1964 hereby appropriate 13 per cent of \$5,000 or \$650 as out share of matching funds, do sponsor this A.W.A.R.E. under the title 2 of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964.
