

Sept. 1, 1960

An organization meeting of the City Council was held on the above date in the Municipal Building at 1:00 P. M.

Vice Mayor Sol Cury acted as Temporary Chairman and asked that the Clerk give the "Oath of Office" to the two incoming Councilmen. #1723

Mr. Cury announced that the floor was now open for nominations for Mayor of City of Norton. #1724

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Clarence Holcomb and carried by unanimous roll call vote, B. E. Ball was appointed as Mayor of City of Norton.

The nominations were now opened for Vice Mayor. The following were nominated: A. O. Umstead and W. R. Hamner. After the votes had been cast, A. O. Umstead was elected Vice Mayor by a majority of votes. #1725

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Miss Jo Nosler was elected as Clerk of Council and Mrs. Shirley Campbell Assistant Clerk of Council. #1726



On motion by F. W. Glass, seconded by Clarence Holcomb and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager, Evan Norton, was reappointed City Manager for the next two years. #1727


On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Clarence Holcomb and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the firm of Greear, Bowen, Mullins, and Winston was appointed as attorney for City of Norton at a fee of \$125.00 per month. It was also stipulated that some member of the firm be present at each council meeting and that they were to serve in accordance with Section 3.923, 24, 25, 26, 27 of the City Charter. #1728

On motion by F. W. Glass, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, H. M. Bandy, Jr. was appointed as police justice of City of Norton at a salary of \$100.00. #1729

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Clarence Holcomb and carried by unanimous vote, Tom Cassell was appointed as issuing justice for City of Norton. #1730

There being no further business before council same adjourned.
