On motion by Fred King, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by #1157 unanimous vote, City Manager, Evan Norton, was appointed as cooridnator for Civil Defense in place of Phil Davis.

On motion by Fred King, seconded by A. O. Umstead, the 1956 delinquent real estate tax list was to be recorded in the Clerk's office at Wise, Virginia, in the manner in which it is customarily filed.

On motion by Fred King, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote, the City Manager, Mr. Norton, was appointed to succeed Mr. Davis as a member of the Norton Welfare Board.

The City Manager presented the Semi-Final Cost estimate of the new dam and gave an estimate of the finanicial condition of the city.

Mr. Hugh Cline inquired of council when the project on Ridge Avenue in front of his property would be completed. Matter referred to City Manager

On motion by Fred King, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote, Mr. Ball was authorized to make settlement with Mr. Kanto as Acting City Manager.

Mr. Ball and Mr. Hamner gave a report of the League of Virginia #1163
Municipality meeting in Richmond.
