

February 4, 1958

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Present: B. E. Ball, Fred H. King, Sol Cury, W. R. Hamner, A. O. Umstead

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Davis, Gordon products salesman for this area appeared before council regarding his license for 1958. Council advised Mr. Davis that his license would be \$100.00. #1227

Mr. Howard Roberts appeared before council regarding road on Ridge Avenue off Henry Street. Referred to City Manager. #1228

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by Sol Cury and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the Fire Prevention Ordinance was passed on Second reading. #1229

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the Model Traffic Ordinance was passed on second reading. #1230

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the House Marking Ordinance was passed on second reading. #1231

A brief discussion of the city's sewer project was held. Mr. Norton presented council with a list of engineers from this section to choose from. Council instructed the City Manager to write letters to the engineers nearest this vicinity to find out their interest in the project. #1232

Mr. Norton presented an estimate from the Michie Company for the recodification of the City Ordinances. Council instructed Mr. Norton to have a representative from The Michie Company down to Norton and confer with the City Manager and City Attorney. #1233

Bids for a new Backhoe were presented to Council. On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the low bid of \$5700 (without the City's old Backhoe) of the Norton Motor Inn was accepted. #1234

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead, the Mayor and City Clerk were authorized to execute the Cooperation Agreement between the City and the Norton Redevelopment and Housing Authority. Fred H. King, not voting. #1235

On a motion by Fred H. King, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote, the following resolution regarding Clinch Valley College was adopted: Refer to Page 87 #1226 #1236


