

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 3, 1984 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, Cliff Daniels, Roy Roberts, Milas Franks, Ray Salyers

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager

Invocation was given by Father Joseph D. Aurora

The Mayor officially welcomed the two new councilmen, Milas Franks & Ray Salyers.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the minutes of regular meeting of June 19th, Special meeting of June 26th and Organizational meeting of July 2nd be approved as presented. 11289

A. Review and Approval of a New Deed for Norton Heights, A Virginia Limited Partnership. Matter tabled until July 17th council meeting. 11290

B. An ordinance Amending & Reordaining Chapter 12 of the Norton City Code, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Stopping, Standing & Parking.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote "An Ordinance Amending & Reordaining Chapter 12 of the Norton City Code, Motor Vehicles and Traffic Stopping, Standing & Parking" be passed on first reading. 11291

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss personnel as Per 2.1-344 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia as amended and Legal Matters as Per 2.1-344 (A) (6) of the Code of Virginia as Amended. 11292

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous vote, council moved they go back into regular session. The Mayor declared Council back in regular session. 11293

Roy Roberts nominated Charlie Daniels to the Norton Industrial Development Authority for a four year term, said term to expire 5-10-84.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed. 11294

The Mayor declared Charlie Daniels appointed to Norton Industrial Development Authority with George Hunnicutt and Cliff Daniels abstaining.

Cliff Daniels nominated Milas Franks for appointment to Lenowisco Board for a period of 4 years, said term to expire June 30, 1988.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved the nominations be closed. 11295

The Mayor declared Milas Franks appointed to Lenowisco Board for a period of four years, said term to expire June 30, 1988.

The Mayor advised that with reference to appointment to City of Norton Planning Commission, according to the City Code a member does not have to be a member of Council. Also find that member could also be a member of City of Norton Board of Zoning Appeals. Appointment deferred for further investigation of a member of Board of Zoning Appeals. 11296

With reference to legal matter, the City Manager is authorized and directed to negotiate for and submit to council for the proposal for a joint water connection between the Town of Wise and City of Norton to area known as Wise Shopping Center down to where Norton water line presently ends in that direction. 11297


Councilman Roberts inquired as to status of ESPN Cable TV Station.
