

A special meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 31, 1983 at 7:00 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Cliff Daniels, Roy Roberts, Vic Jones

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

The Mayor announced at this time there would be a public hearing on the proposed budget for year 1983-1984.

The Mayor ask that the City Manager read all the headings of the proposed budget. After the City Manager read the headings of each department in the entire budget, the Mayor pointed out that there was a proposed decrease in real estate tax of 10¢ per \$100 and a proposed decrease in License Tax Fee for Professional persons from \$.58 to \$.50. 10880

The Mayor also advised there was a proposed increase of 10% in water & Sewer Rates, Elimination of the \$50.00 Maximum Charge for Sewer Service, A change in Tap Fee Rates and a New Category for out of the City Sewer Rates Plus other minor changes.

Several citizens present spoke on the budget with the point most in concern was the reduction of real estate tax rates. Some of them spoke on the subject of water rates. Each of the councilmen spoke on these subjects. No definite action was taken on first reading. Second reading will be at regular meeting on June 7th.

The City Manager read the proposed Revenue Sharing Budget in its entirety.


The Mayor announced that the school board had some legal matter to take up with council and advised that only by unanimous consent could council do so.


On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that go into executive session for purpose of considering legal matter which requires a unanimous consent of the council. 10881

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved go back into regular session.

The Mayor reported that school board needed an answer to some legal questions and that the city attorney had not been advised of this beforehand and was unable to answer their questions at the present time.
