Request to accept low bid of Barnette Contractors, Inc. for Drainage Work on 6th Street and Park Avenue in the amount of \$78,738.63. Council discussed this drainage situation at length with the City Manager.

The Mayor declared council back in regular session.

The Mayor advised that with regard to consultation with the City Attorney, they were not yet ready to divulge the information.

The Mayor announced it was now in order for nominations to Mountain Empire Older Citizens Advisory Board for a two year term.

W.F. McElroy nominated Anne Massey for reappointment to Mountain Empire Older Citizens Advisory Board.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved the nominations be closed.

The Mayor declared Anne D. Massey as member of Mountain Empire Older Citizens Advisory Board for two year term, said term to expire Sept. 15, 1985.
