

Council held a special meeting on October 30, 1979 in the Municipal Building with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Mayor Hunnicutt advised that the first part of this meeting was to be a work session with the City of Norton School Board. All members of the School Board was present. Also Dr. Grahm and members of P.T.A. and other school representatives was present. Different members of School Board and Council spoke on mutual problems of school and city. The Council and school board members agreed that they would like to have a better understanding of their mutual problems. They were of the opinion that meetings of this type would help them in solving some of these problems.

Representatives of Thompson & Litton were present and discussed with council Phase II of the 201 Sewer Study. After a lengthy discussion council agreed for the City Manager to contact Town of Wise and County of Wise with regard to their participation in the program and report back to council at a later date.

1. Audit has been completed and submitted to HUD office in Richmond.
2. Need to authorize someone to draw down CD Funds from Treasury Dept. in lieu of his signature.
3. Advised of two pieces of property owned by Development on S.S.; one of new developed playground and one on front of R.R. crossing at Route 74 and 58. He stated this should be city property instead of housing property.
4. Status of projects previously supervised by T. & L..

Council discussed the change in project in which T. & L. supervised in line that difference in contract cost due to change in original contract.




